

 - Level 3 Complete the remaining 5 challenges to be entered into the grand prize drawing.
- A separate book must be used for each challenge.
- Come into the library to pick up a copy of the challenge. When you complete a level, fill out the level disc included in the challenge packet and return it to the library to collect your prize.
